## **Samples**

#### **Sample Bottles**

PLEASE use only NEW bottles. If you need some, let us know and we will figure out how to get them to you - or let us know which cooler you use so that we can be sure there is enough in the cooler for pick-up in June.

#### Keep your samples cold

PLEASE be sure to put ice in your yellow coolers! It is imperative that the samples not get warm. If you need a cooler and/or ice pack, let us know and we will get one to you.

#### Remember to sign in your sample

PLEASE be sure to sign your samples into the cooler on the sign in sheet. We are required to have a chain of custody for the EPA's Credible Data Program. If samples are not signed in - they might not get run. To make this easier, let Teresa know which cooler you use <a href="mailto:barnest@bceo.org">barnest@bceo.org</a>. We will have your sample ID's typed on the list. Then, all you have to do is sign, date, and time it for each sample.

### **Coolers**

#### Which Cooler Do you Use?

## Free Music Festival- June 13.


