Stream Team Volunteers Carol Jones

One of our most consistent volunteers for the last 2 years is Carol Jones. She samples 10-14 sites each month in the Middletown/Trenton area and brings the cooler from Barn-N-Bunk to lab. **Thanks, Carol!**

Her interest in streams and their stewardship seems NOT to stem from "nature deficit disorder": "My interest in ground water and streams was born as a child, with my brother and I exploring the 9 acres we grew up on. We spent our childhood overturning every stone in the small stream (run) on the property (not knowing much except tadpoles and such...) We learned all the native trees, birds, etc. I remember crawling through a field tile into the creek on the back of the property." Carol's parents hosted a 4-H Conservation Club for the neighboring kids that visited the area that would become Acton Lake. "Most of my Girl Scout badges are animal or nature related", Carol says.

Carol is proud that the bulk of her life's work since age 19, aside from family and farm, has been

Crisis Spot

As you are out sampling or just out for a walk along the waterways and see something wrong, email us. We always want to hear from our volunteers and especially if there is a problem that can be corrected.

You are our eyes in the field, the first line of defense for streams in Butler County when there is a problem. Once the problems have been reported to us, we can pass it along to the appropriate agencies. For instance, Carol Jones's interest in streams led her sister to make her aware of cleared brush in her local creek. When Carol contacted us, Doug Dirksing contacted Duke Energy, who passing on what she learned from Recovery International, a mental health organization based in Chicago. RI provides weekly self-help, peer-support/training meetings locally, by telephone, and online, to persons suffering from mental and nervous illnesses. Carol leads an RI-Discovery group meeting on Tuesdays, one of five groups in Area 140 Greater Cincinnati/Louisville. In 1999, she became Area Leader, and now is an Area Team member, serving as Contact.

"Thousands of RI members say that participating in this program not only saved our lives, but gave us tools to strengthen our nerve resistance and growth to thrive, in spite of our illness. RI can be an adjunct to professional care, or strictly for self-help. When we become healthy through use of the tools we learn in RI, we enjoy life and make the most of it.
