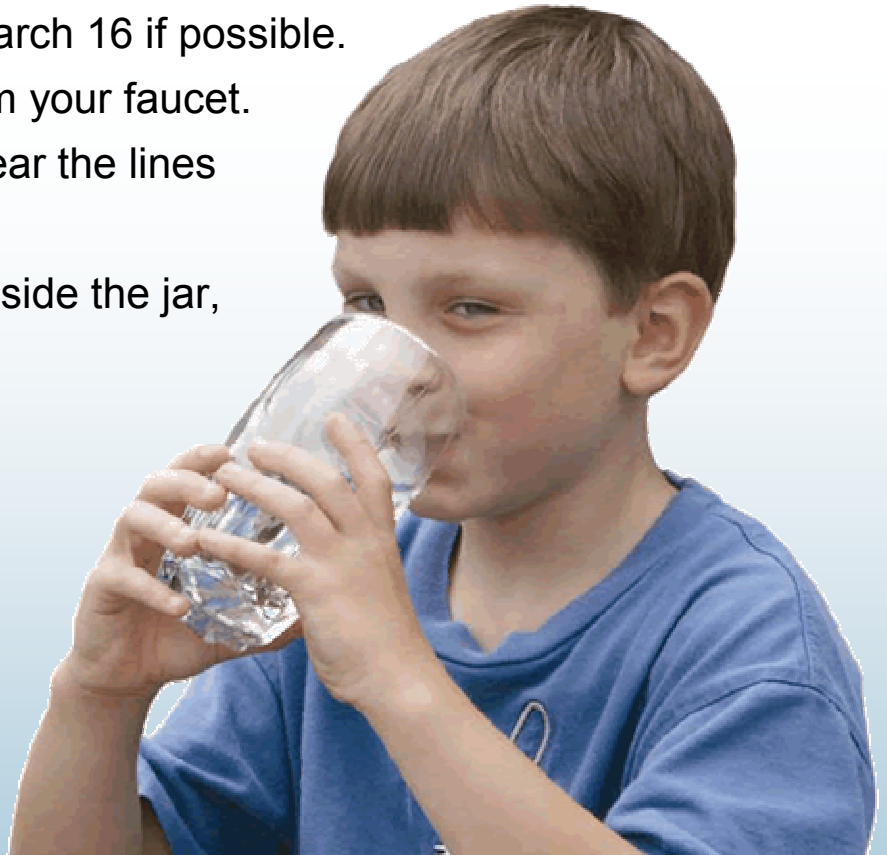
## **Who should participate?**

- **Is your home's well more than 40 years old?**
- **Is it less than 50 feet deep?**
- **Has it been more than a year since the water was tested?**

If you answered **yes** to any of these questions, bring a well water sample to the Free Workshop. Within about 30 minutes, you'll know if there might be a hazardous level of nitrate in your water.

## **To collect your well water sample properly:**

- Any clean jar that seals tightly will work. Or pick up a sample bottle from St Clair Twp Fire Department or the Butler Soil & Water Conservation District.
- Plan to collect the sample on March 16 if possible.
- Remove any screen or filter from your faucet.
- Run water for five minutes to clear the lines and bring in fresh water.
- Do not touch the lip of the jar, inside the jar, or inside of the cap.
- Fill the bottle and cap it snugly.
- Refrigerate the sample until the Workshop.
- Bring your sample to the event between 5:30 and 7:30 pm on March 16.
